A Day in the Life

The Wellness Manager is responsible for the overall health and wellness of campers and staff at Big Cove YMCA Camp. They will assess each camper for pre-existing health issues upon arrival as well as sign in any medications that campers bring. Primary responsibilities throughout the week include: sorting and dispensing medications at the appropriate times, assessing camper wellness throughout the week and providing appropriate interventions, managing first aid situations which require additional support and communicating health concerns with campers families as needed.

The Wellness Manager also plays a role in the overall operation of camp and is encouraged to be involved in all program activities and getting to know campers outside the health centre.

Main areas of responsibility include:

- Assess patients to identify appropriate nursing interventions;
- Dispense and administer medications and treatments as prescribed by a physician;
- Monitor, assess, address, document, and report symptoms and changes in patients' conditions;
- Provide health education; and
- Provide general care to patients.
